We advise you to indicate in the **Title** or the **core text of the abstract**, the relation to the CRC by using either the **CRC acronym** or the mention **"an ERS Clinical Research Collaboration"**.

This will allow the ERS Office to sort your abstract from the thousands of submissions and to give it more visibility through dedicated communications.

As a reminder, the deadline to submit abstracts for the ERS Congress 2025 is 20 February 2025 .
