Strengthening the screening of Lung Cancer in Europe

Lung cancer is the leading cause of death from cancer. As with all cancers, survival rates are much higher when it is caught early. There are many reasons that individuals at risk are not accessing lung cancer screening. Often, this relates to historical inequalities that exist with marginalised and vulnerable communities. Factors, such as smoking, can be more prevalent in these groups, further compounding their risk of lung cancer.

SOLACE aims at developing, testing and disseminating tools to help overcome identified bottlenecks and specifically address the health inequalities in different European countries. It will provide a toolbox for individualised approaches for lung cancer screening on a national or regional level.


