1 INTRODUCTION OF OUR ORGANISATION

VPS Lakeshore Hospital and Research Centre in Kochi is one of the largest (500 bedded) most comprehensive multi-specialty hospitals in Kerala, India. Over the years the hospital has merged as a center of international healthcare excellence for patients in India and abroad through a broad range of advanced clinical programs and cutting-edge treatment and diagnostic services. The hospital also runs fellowships and postgraduate causes in various super-specialty departments under the National Board of Examinations (NBE). The spirit of research has always been kept alive at VPS Lakeshore, The hospital supports pioneering research and is used to conduct various academic programs and public education.

BACKGROUND

Kochi, a port city, in the Ernakulam district of Kerala, has an estimated population of 3 million. Kochi is known for its rich cultural heritage, vibrant trade, and picturesque backwaters. However, like many rapidly urbanizing areas, Kochi faces significant challenges related to air pollution. It is an important port town and houses the Southern Naval Command of the armed forces, the largest international container trans-shipment terminal in India, the Cochin shipyard, and the offshore mooring of the Bharath Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL). It is also an important chemical industrial and manufacturing hub and an emerging information technology center in Kerala.

Sources of Air Pollution: The sources of air pollution in Kochi are varied and multifaceted. Rapid urbanization and population growth have led to an increase in vehicular traffic, which is one of the primary contributors to deteriorating air quality. Emissions from buses, cars, and two-wheelers release significant amounts of particulate matter (PM), nitrogen oxides (NOx), and sulfur dioxide (SO2) into the atmosphere. Additionally, industrial activities and construction projects contribute further to the pollution levels, often releasing toxic pollutants.

Brahmapuram Landfill Fire: The fire incident at Brahmapuram waste plant, the largest waste plant with a 110-acre open biomining segregating and conversion center incident which happened in March 2023 made the city like a gas chamber. The massive uncontrolled fire created serious air pollution and subsequently, people from nearby areas were evacuated and Hundreds were admitted to nearby hospitals with respiratory problems and worsening cardiac and respiratory conditions. After this serious measure was taken for waste segregation, avoiding open dumping and burning of waste materials. Various activities regarding clean air and pulmonary health issues were done in and around Kochi. We

Lakeshore Hospital was also involved in conducting medical camps in the Brahmapuram area for those affected by the fire.

Mitigation Efforts: Addressing air pollution in Kochi requires a multifaceted approach. The local government has begun implementing measures to reduce emissions, such as promoting public transportation, encouraging the use of electric vehicles, and improving traffic management. Public awareness campaigns are also essential to educate citizens about the sources and effects of air pollution, motivating them to adopt cleaner practices. Additionally, enhancing green spaces in the city can help mitigate air pollution. Trees and vegetation act as natural air filters, absorbing pollutants and releasing oxygen. Urban planning that incorporates parks and green belts can significantly improve air quality and the overall health of the urban ecosystem.

2 GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF HEALTHY LUNG FOR LIFE -KOCHI

- 1-To educate regarding the importance of clean air.
- 2- To spread awareness regarding reducing air pollution.
- 3-To communicate the need for exercise for a healthy life and healthy lung.
- 4-To find out people suffering from chronic lung conditions like asthma, COPD, ILD and allergies.
- 5-To educate people regarding the importance of vaccinations, smoking cessation.

3 PROGRAM OVERVIEW AND STRUCTURE

We conducted camping inside the hospital from 25 to 30 September 2024 and one day 28th September outside the hospital at Lulu Mall Kochi. (Largest mall in India)

Through the program, we offered the public.

- 1-Free screening consultation
- 2-Free PFT
- 3-Vaccination guidance
- 4-Smoking cessation guidance
- 5-Awareness regarding pollution and Air Quality
- 6-Activities like inflating balloons and cycling were also performed.

The campaign started on 25 September 2024 as a part of World Lung Health Day celebrations. The chief guest Hospital Managing Director Mr. SK Abdulla inaugurated the program. Pulmonologists Dr Mujeeb Rahman and Dr Hari Lakshman delivered a talk on

pollution and lung health. Dr H Ramesh (Medical superintendent), and Dr Shawn Joseph (Chief Medical Officer) delivered talks on various messages related to Lung Health covering the importance of air pollution, the need for clean air, and the importance of vaccination and exercise.
