THE PRESS LAUNCH

The press launch was attended by the mayor of Milan and the president of Lombardy. Whilst they are politically opposed on many issues, we were able to get them both in the same room and create a well-attended press event with around 50 **reporters in attendance**. From this we appeared in over 250 print and online articles and ensured that our message linking negative health outcomes to air pollution got through to a wide audience.



Working in partnership with Forestami, the team visited the city centre on 8 and 9 September to offer a 'forest pavilion' and spirometry testing. The Italian public were given a free lung test and the opportunity to sign a petition to show their support for clean air policies and learn more about how to keep lungs healthy.
